40 Years Ago

December, 1967

Bert Miller was the new SVR R.E. In this issue, he spoke about what this club could do for an encore. SCCA preferred that a small region would have to maintain at least 50 members. Although SVR started with only 19...it finished the year with eighty-one! Some other SVR statistics from 1967: SVR owned.. 1 trailer, 89 pylons, a P.A. System, a three headed electric timer (Brian Rebney probably still has it, or it is in the archives with Larry Hall?), cable, 6 stop watches, a portable typewriter, a ditto machine, 2 coffee makers, 2 fire ext., a Ciquiligraph, (do you suppose this was the name tag machine? Tom), a screen & projector and \$250.00 in the check book.

30 Years Ago

December, 1977

Karen Light was taking reservations for the up coming wine tasting party at the Das Michigan Haus. SVR had only 35 members, SCCA had increased its membership to 18,932. The SVR checking account had \$1300.00. Dick Lieber, Jim Doidge, Clark Bond, Roger Suppes, Wayne Grubaugh & Terry Rueter were going to build a club trailer. The SVR Board voted to require the use of helmets at all ice runs.

20 Years Ago

Dec. 1987, Jan. 1988

SVR planned an auction on Dec. 16 to provide funds to replace the old copy machine. The 1987 CenDiv Round table would be held in Beloit, WI. & attended by the Halls & the Boreens. The 1988 Round table was scheduled for Frankenmuth, MI. & sponsored by SVR. Judy Hudak announced that the Awards Banquet this year would be at the Pioneer Club in Saginaw and the guest speaker would be Tom McDonald of Pontiac Cadillac GMC.

10 Years Ago

Dec. 1997, Jan. 1998

The Checkpoint cover had photos of Jeff Ervin in his GT-1 Mustang Cobra & Kent Biddinger in his A/S Mustang at the Valvoline Runoffs. R.E. Norm Dively thanked everyone on the Board for their cooperation & effort in making 1997 a very successful year for SVR. Norm also recapped the year, whereby, SVR did 5 solo events with an average of 71 cars per event, and a "test and tune" event with 43 cars. The BFG June event had 181 entrants, which was the largest number of entrants for the eight event series. SVR placed 3rd in the voting for event of the year. SVR sent the largest percentage of members to the Solo Nationals of any region. Those members returned with a fair share of hardware as well. And the combination Rally & Wine Tasting event produced a 15 car rally entry and a sell out of the wine tasting.

Mitch McGill wrote about possibly securing Sunrise Lake, south of Cadillac for the '98 Ice Run season. Tom Hudak wrote about the October Vino Rally & Wine Tasting party. Brian Rebney did a good job of finding interesting roads in the Frankenmuth area. The rally was won by Bert & Jerry Pat Miller of Midland, former SVR members; 2nd Place went to Sandra Dively & Raleigh Boreen; and 3rd place went to Curt McGill & Mitch McGill.

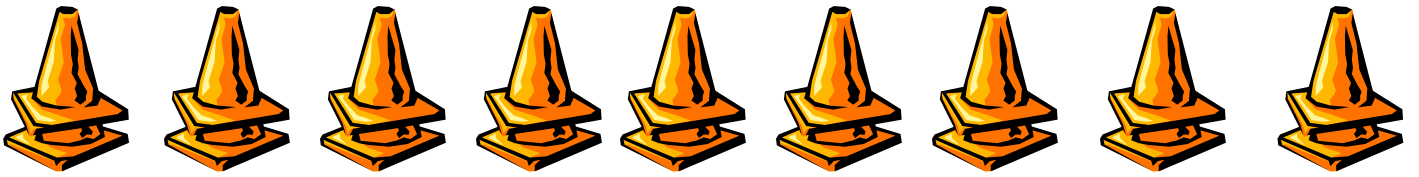
